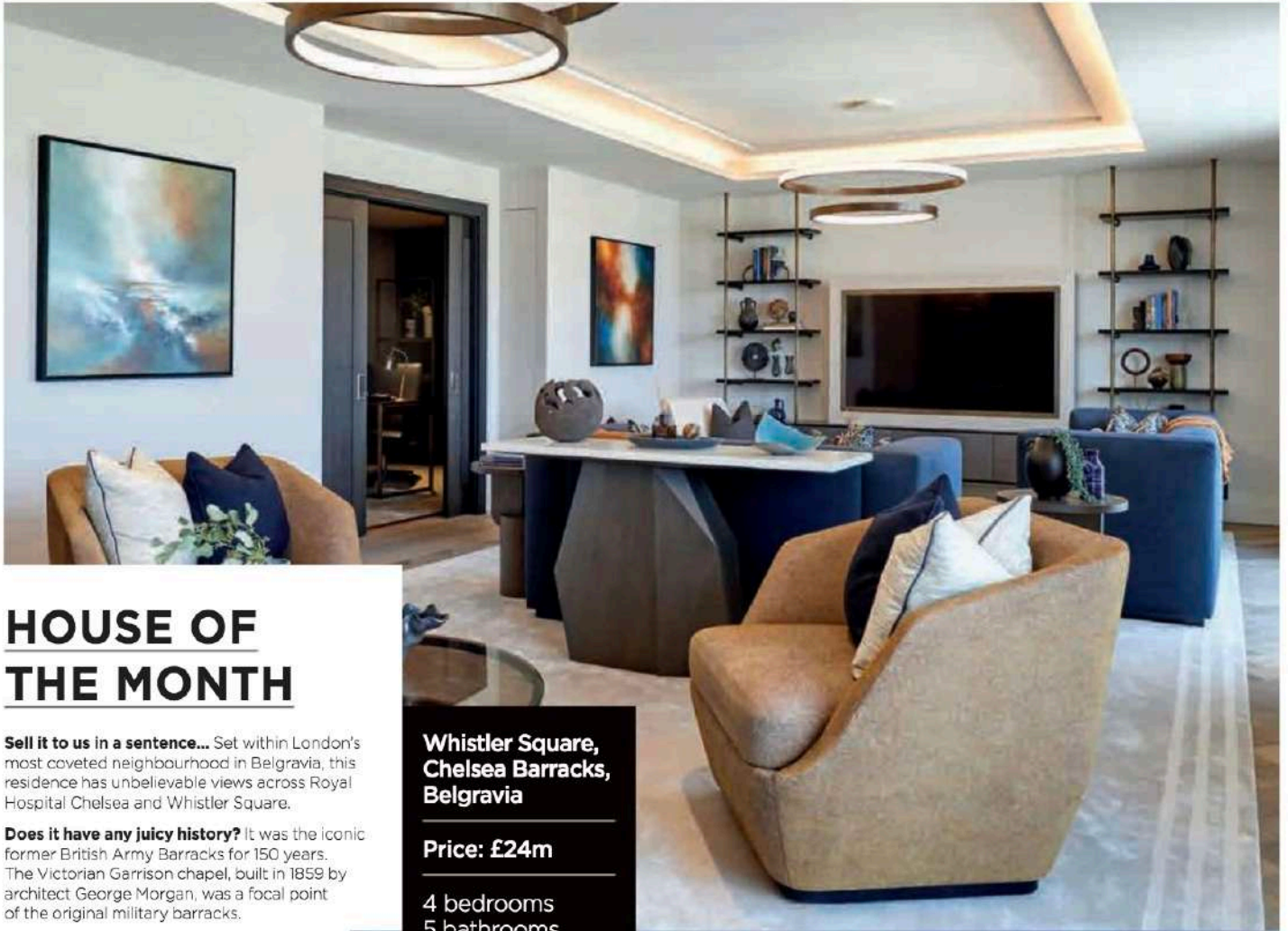

## HOUSE OF THE MONTH

**Sell it to us in a sentence...** Set within London's most coveted neighbourhood in Belgravia, this residence has unbelievable views across Royal Hospital Chelsea and Whistler Square.

**Does it have any juicy history?** It was the iconic former British Army Barracks for 150 years. The Victorian Garrison chapel, built in 1859 by architect George Morgan, was a focal point of the original military barracks.

**Who is behind the design?** Elicyon, which has woven delicate military details into the design and clever rivet detailing inspired by the nearby Chelsea Bridge.

**Most unusual feature?** From one side of the apartment you can see across Whistler Square and the London skyline, including The London Eye and the Shard, and from the other side, out across the Royal Hospital Chelsea and its gardens.

**What would parties be like here?** At the Garrison Club downstairs, guests can retreat to the residents lounge for after-dinner drinks, or the billiards room for games and drams from the whisky store.

**Perks of the area?** Garrison Square will be the hub of the new community with smart shops, a gallery (within the original Garrison Chapel) and a pop-up restaurant by Michelin-starred chef Ollie Dabbous.

**What are the neighbours like?** They are the Chelsea Pensioners at Royal Hospital Chelsea just across the road.

**We like its style but want somewhere bigger – are there more like this?** There are 13 townhouses, which preserve the architectural integrity of the traditional townhouse. You'll need to dig deep though as townhouses start from £38m.
